- Funded for 5 Years by The Ford Foundation


Vision (developed almost 10 years ago)

 3. To increase cadre of human resources using standardised training and resource materials for improving quality

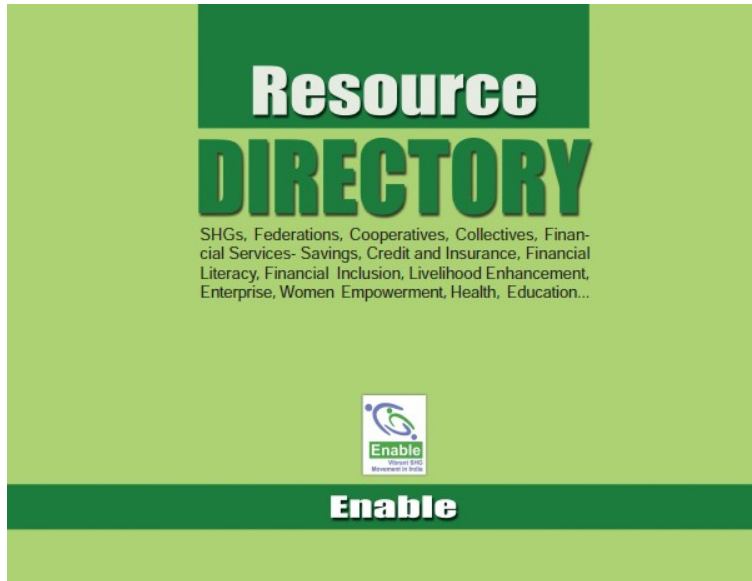

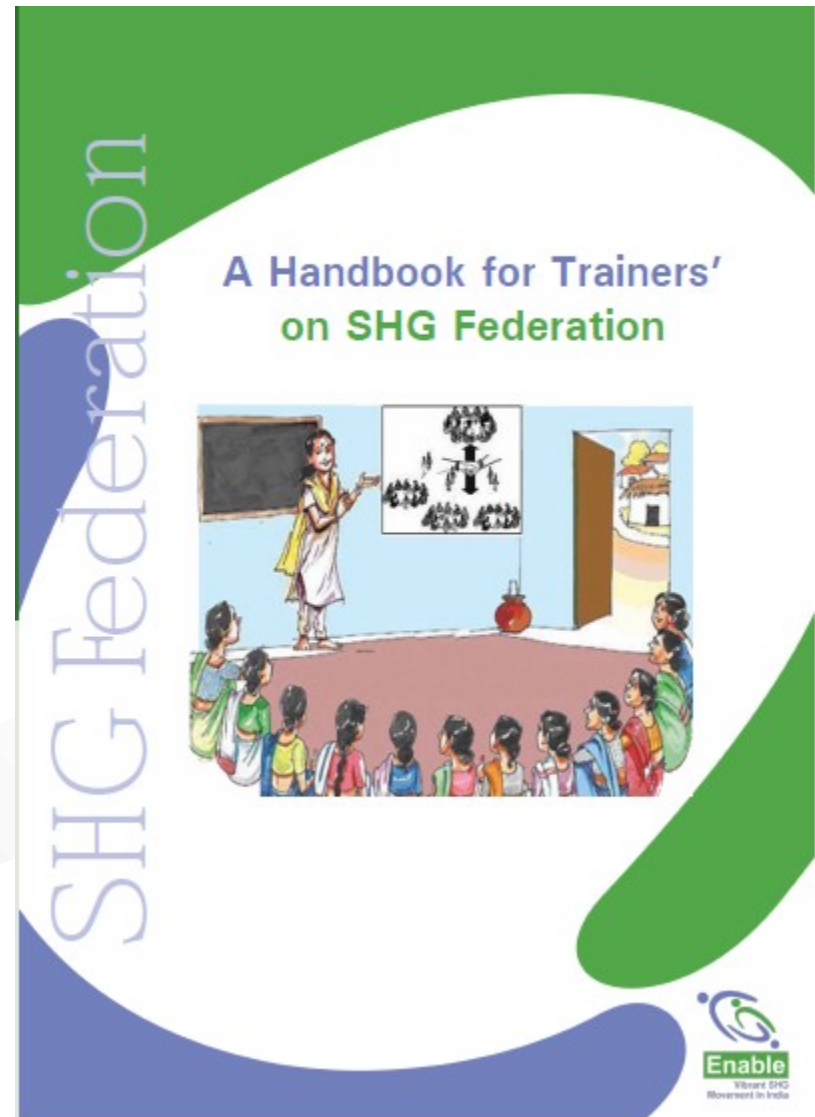
